The Elections for the Executive Committee for Gymnastics Federation of India were held on



12<sup>th</sup> August 2015 at Hotel Ashok Chankyapuri New Delhi for the term 2015-2019 which was attended by 35 members from 18 units i. e. Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Chandigarh, Delhi, Goa, Gujrat, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, Maharashtra, Jharkhand, Manipur, Odisha, Punjab, Railways, SSCB, Tripura, Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand after the instructions of the Honorable High Court New Delhi. The elections were conducted by Justice P. K. Bhasin (Retired Judge Delhi

High Court) acting as returning officer in presence of Mr. Hoshiyar Singh Bhadu (Observer IOA) and Mr. R. K. Saxena (Government Observer).

The polling was held only for the post of General Secretary from 11.00 AM to 2.30 PM at



Hotel Ashok Chankyapuri New Delhi, where only two valid nominations found after the mass rejection of 12 nominations i. e. one of Mr. Kaushik Bidiwala from Gujrat and another of Mr. Shanti Kumar Singh from Manipur. The result was declared by Justice P. K. Bhasin at 3.00 PM which was <u>won by Mr. Shanti Kumar Singh with</u> a margin of 20-14 votes. Other members as

Dipa Karmakar, Golden Girl of 35<sup>th</sup> National Games Kerala 2015 again created history in



Indian Gymnastics and became the first Indian women to win a Bronze Medal in Table Vault (14.725) by performing the highest value vault i. e, <u>Hand Spring Double Salto Tucked</u> in 6<sup>th</sup> Senior Asian Artistic Gymnastics Championship Hiroshima Japan from 31<sup>st</sup> July to 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2015. Earlier Ashish Kumar became the first Indian men to win a Bronze medal in Floor at 3<sup>rd</sup> Senior Asian Artistic Gymnastics Championship Surat India in 2006. Dipa Karmakar was ranked 7<sup>th</sup> in Competition No-II with 52.400 points. She qualified for C-III in Table Vault with 14.500 points. It is worth to mention that Dipa scored 15.325 points in 2<sup>nd</sup> vault which was the highest

score among all the 8 qualified gymnasts. Dipa Karmakar also qualified for C-III in Balance



Beam with 13.600 points and ranked 8<sup>th</sup> with 12.475 in final, while not a single men gymnast qualify for the Competition-III. All credit goes to Dipa Karmakar & her Coach Mr. B. S. Nandi for this grand achievement out the Asian Gymnastics Power House to make India Proud. We are also proud of you and expect the better achievements from you in 46<sup>th</sup> World Gymnastics Championships to be held in October 2015 at Glasgow Scotland. **Dipa Karmakar bestowed with the**

## TRIBUTE TO DR. DRASHAN KUMAR TANDON (NATIONAL COACH)

Dr. D. K. Tandon was born at Delhi on 11<sup>th</sup> May 1937. He was graduated from Kathmandu

Nepal and passed the 3<sup>rd</sup> Adhoc Gymnastics Course from erstwhile National Institute of Sports (NIS) under Foreign Experts along with Captain Bhikaji Bhonsle (Olympian 1964) and Major Patang Mohite. He joined as Gymnastics Coach in National Institute of Sports and was posted at Rohtak (Haryana) and Jaipur (Rajasthan) till 1968 and did his Diploma in Gymnastics from Leipzig Institute of Sports East Germany in 1969. Later, he joined Late V. B. Pillai the then Chief Coach, faculty of gymnastics at NSNIS Patiala for Regular Diploma Courses in 1970. He



was the National Coach as well as In-charge of the National Coaching Camp for Junior Gymnasts at NIS Patiala in 1971 in preparation of 1<sup>st</sup> Asian Youth Gymnastics Championship, which was held at Tokyo Japan. Finally, Indian Team comprising of the top gymnasts of the country namely Nirbhaya Singh, Manjit Singh Gill, Daljit Inder Singh, Inderjit Singh, Nemai Kanji, Mantu Debnath, Pratap Chand Rana & Madhusudan Saha in Men while Ambalika Mazumdar, Aarati Das, Nilima Gaul, Prabhjot Kaur, Vijay Laxmi, Manju Lata, Kumdesh Khosala and Lopa Mudra Ghosh in Women participated in 1<sup>st</sup> Asian Youth Gymnastics Championship held at Japan and Dr. Tandon accompanied as coach for Men and Women teams.

Dr. Tandon was the great educationist and worked very hard for the development of the

gymnastics in country. Dr. Tandon also conducted first Judges Course in MAG & WAG at Mumbai in 1978 with the help of Late Mr. Kalyanpurkar, Mr. Ram Dutta & Mr. Nirbhaya Singh. He was the person, who started the organization of National Gymnastics Championships in India as per FIG Technical Regulations for the first time at Surat in 1979. His prominent disciples in gymnastics to whom he taught / guided and helped to achieve high performance and career in gymnastics such as Dr. P. C. Kashyap National Champion & former Executive Director SAI New Delhi, Dr. G. S. Bawa National Coach & former head of the department gymnastics NIS Patiala, Mr. Mantu Debnath National Champion & Arjun Awardee, Dr. Kalpana Debnath National Champion & Arjun Awardee, Dr. R. C. Sharma former head of the department Biomechanics NIS Patiala, Mr. R. N. Mangla former head of the department gymnastics NIS Kolkata, Mr. Nemai Kanji National Champion, International Gymnast & former head of the

department gymnastics NIS Kolkata, Mr. Nirbhaya Singh National Champion & former head of the department gymnastics NIS Patiala, Mr. Manjit Singh Panther National Champion & International Gymnast and Mr. Ram Niwas former National Champion & Government Observer Ministry of Sports & Youth Affairs New Delhi.

Dr. D. K. Tandon did his Master of Sport from Leipzig Institute of Sports East Germany in



1974-1976 and joined faculty of gymnastics at NIS Patiala as Chief Gymnastics Coach. He was the driving force to to start Master of Sports for Indian Coaches to enhance their educational qualification and started 1<sup>st</sup> Master of Sport with Dr. G. S. Bawa and Mr. Surjit Singh Walia for the period 1979-1981 and 2<sup>nd</sup> Masters with Mr. R. N. Mangla and Mr. Kamal Krishan for 1980-1982. In 1978, the gymnastics was included first time in Commonwealth Games at Edmonton and Indian Gymnastics team of Nemai Kanji, Manjit Singh Panther, B. S. Nandi and N. B. Bhonsle along

with Dr. D. K. Tandon as coach participated in the 11<sup>th</sup> Commonwealth Games at Edmonton, Canada in 1978. Dr. Tandon was also attached with Indian Cricket team in 1980's as **Conditioning Expert**. What a co-incident of this great personality that <u>he was born on 11<sup>th</sup></u>, <u>he passed away on 11<sup>th</sup> and was the coach of Indian team in 11<sup>th</sup> Commonwealth Games at</u> <u>Edmonton, Canada.</u> Dr. Tandon was deputed as Technical Director for IX Asian Games at New Delhi in 1981 for the smooth conduct of the games. He also completed his Doctorate from East Germany and joined the Sports Directorate of Uttar Pradesh at K D Singh Babu Stadium Lucknow as Director in 1984. He then promoted as Regional Director and sent to SAI Eastern Centre Kolkata in November 1986 and remains there up to May 1990. He then took the charge as Executive Director Academics at NIS Patiala and worked till his retirement. Dr. D. K. Tandon retired on 31<sup>st</sup> May 1995 at the age of 58 years. He was DDG Technical in IOA and Sports Administrator with University Grant Commission at New Delhi but could not continue for a long time and decided to be at Gurgaon (Harvana) but health conditions did not allow him to continue at Gurgaon and shifted to Old Age Home at Burdhman Hospital, Malviya Nagar New Delhi. He dedicated his whole life for the cause of Gymnastics and remained bachelor throughout his life. Later due to Hip Pelvic Bone fracture, Dr. Tandon was admitted to ATLANTA Hospital, Sector-14, Vasundra, Gaziabad (Uttar Pradesh). Recently he was shifted to Dementia Care Home; Sector-11 Faridabad under Dr. Lalit Kumar due to critical conditions, where he had his last breath on 11<sup>th</sup> July 2015 at 5.30 AM which was a great loss to Indian Gymnastics, Gymnastics Federation of India (GFI), its coaches and Gymnasts and was cremated at Lodhi Road Crematorium Delhi at 12.30 PM. We, on behalf of the Indian Gymnastics Fraternity pay our heartfelt tribute to the departed soul and pray to almighty that his soul may rest in eternal peace.
